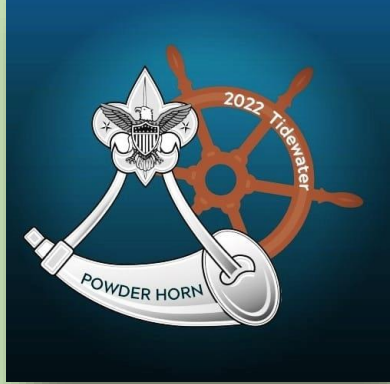


Who should attend?
