

The Jon-Christian Carroll Memorial Eagle Scout Scholarship



The Jon-Christian Carroll Memorial Eagle Scout Scholarship is established to honor the legacy of Jon-Christian “Jon-Jon” Carroll, a beloved Son, Brother, Friend, Eagle Scout and United States Marine who prematurely departed this world in 2020. He is missed dearly by many.

Jon-Jon began his scouting career as a Cub Scout in pack 544 later transitioning to Troop 544 and attaining the rank of Eagle Scout. Jon-Jon attended the first National Jamboree held at the Summit Bechtel Reserve and numerous summer camps. He loved Scouting and being active in his troop. Additionally, he earned a Black Belt in Tae Kwon Do, played Soccer, and loved Hiking and Mountain Biking.

After graduating from High School, Jon-Jon enlisted in the United States Marine Corps earning the title United States Marine in 2017.

This scholarship aims to support Eagle Scouts who demonstrate exceptional leadership, community service, and academic achievement.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Must be a current or former Eagle Scout
2. Must be a high school senior or junior
3. Must demonstrate a commitment to community service and leadership
4. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5

Application Requirements:

1. Completed scholarship application form
2. A personal statement (maximum 1,000 words) detailing how Scouting has impacted your life and how you plan to continue serving your community
3. Two letters of recommendation (one from a Scout leader and one from a teacher, counselor or community leader)
4. Proof of Eagle Scout rank
5. Official high school or college transcripts

Award Amount:

The scholarship will award \$500 annually to one or more recipients.

Selection Process:

The Council Advancement Committee will appoint a scholarship review team to review all applications and select the recipient(s) based on the eligibility criteria and application requirements.

Deadline:

Applications must be received or postmarked by December 31 each year.
